INTRODUCTION

On June 27, 2011, the AISD Board of Trustees adopted Policy BDF(Local), which is attached in its entirety. This policy was the culmination of discussions with the Board on ways to improve and standardize the district's various advisory bodies. The Board acknowledged the need for structure, consistency, and transparency in order for advisory bodies to work effectively and openly. Following is an overview of major provisions of the policy.

The policy provides an overview of the structure of District Advisory Bodies and the staff coordinators assigned to each committee and templates. The policy further states that the prepared bylaws and charters shall be reviewed and approved by each committee. Adoption does not mean approval. Adoption means that each committee shall acknowledge and commit to follow its charter or bylaws.
